Your letter was received electronically on August 3, 2018, and is viewed as an application for public records subject to the Maryland Public Information Act, MD. CODE ANN., GENERAL PROVISIONS ARTICLE §§ 4-101 to 4-601 (2014) (“the Act”) and Superintendent’s Rule 2373. A copy of Rule 2373 is enclosed.

According to your letter, you seek a copy of the following record of the Baltimore County Public Schools:

1. “...I am requesting an opportunity to inspect or obtain copies of the Financial Disclosure Statement Destruction Logs for BCPS employees for years 2012 to 2018.”


## *Response*
