Narrative Information

On the above listed date and time, I responded to Holabird Middle School in reference to an officer in need of assistance call (Signal 13).

Upon my arrival to the school, I observed several other officers attempted to handcuff a large black male subject.

After several additional seconds of several officers forcing the suspect's arms behind his back, he was able to be handcuffed. The subject was identified to be _____, the suspect listed above. This identity was confirmed through the school database.



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The suspect was then transported to the Dundalk Precinct by Officer Smith #6051 for processing.

An investigation revealed that _____ an assistant principal, was attempting to conduct a reasonable suspicion search of the suspect's locker. It was suspected that the suspect may have possessed a lighter either on his person, within his belongings, or within his locker. Upon opening the students locker, _____ stated that Officer Matthews asked the suspect to step back away from the locker. The suspect did so slightly and Officer Matthews then asked the suspect to step back away from the locker again. The suspect this time refused. His proximity to Officer Matthews was extremely close. Officer Matthews then made contact with the suspect (chest to chest). The suspect then shoved Officer Matthews. Officer Matthews then swung at the suspect. The suspect then punched Officer Matthews in the face several times. The suspect and Officer Matthews then grappled with one another. This resulted in the suspect lifting Officer Matthews off of the ground and knocking him to the ground. The suspect threw several more punch blows at Officer Matthews while he was on the ground. These punches were mostly towards the back of Officer Matthew's head. Then _____ a teacher, intervened and moved the suspect away from officer Matthews and against the lockers.

_____, a teacher, was also present with _____; as this incident occurred. Her observations were identical to _____ observations of this incident.

_____ stated that he observed Officer Matthews and the suspect involved in a struggle. He observed the suspect throw several punches at Officer Matthews. Officer Matthews was on his back in a defensive position by the time _____ reached he and the suspect. The suspect was also hovering over Officer Matthews at this point, attempting to overwhelm him with a flurry of punches. As _____ reached the struggle, the suspect's back was to him. _____ physically moved the suspect away from Officer Matthews in an attempt to prevent any further danger. _____ held the suspect away from Officer Matthews for approximately two minutes, verbally deescalating him. Officer Matthews then attempted to hand cuff the suspect, engaging one cuff to the suspect's left wrist. At this point, the suspect began to resist and physically break away from _____ and Officer Matthews. The suspect verbally taunted Officer Matthews as he continued to attempt to take him into custody. Officer Matthews remained calm and continued to attempt to subdue the suspect. At this point another teacher, _____ arrived to the scene and attempted to restrain the suspect's right arm. _____ remarked that it was at this point that he realized that the three men could not "fully control," the suspect. Officer Matthews then used his police radio to request back up.

_____ stated that when he arrived to the scene, he observed the suspect physically resisting the commands of Officer Matthews. The suspect continued to move and attempt to break his right arm free from the grasp of he, Officer Matthews, and _____. Officer Matthews then called for further police assistance to help subdue the suspect.

I next viewed archived surveillance footage of this incident. At approximately 1310 hours (per the clock on the video surveillance system) the suspect, _____ and Officer Matthews approach a row of lockers. A short time later, Officer Matthews steps between the suspect and the locker. He appears to make contact with the suspect's chest as he steps into this position. The suspect can then be seen shoving Officer Matthews. Punches are then exchanges between the suspect and Officer Matthews. The two then begin to grapple and both eventually go to the ground. Officer Matthews is on his back and the suspect regains his footing first. The suspect then begins throwing several punch at the top of Officer Matthews' head. The suspect is then moved away from Officer Matthews by _____. Officer Matthews then re-



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approaches the suspect and attempts to handcuff him. Officer Matthews, _____, and _____ all struggle to subdue the suspect as Officer Matthews attempts to complete the handcuffing procedure. At approximately 1317 hours additional officers can be seen arriving to the scene. A short time later the suspect is subdued and handcuffed.

I returned to The Dundalk Precinct and processed the suspect by having him fingerprinted and photographed. While I was doing this, Officer Topper #5186 spoke with _____ She explained the form 117R and _____ signed the form 117R.

A short time later, I released the suspect to _____ They left the precinct with no further incident.

On 5/31/19, it was discovered that Officer Matthews' eyeglasses had been destroyed during this incident.

Also on 5/31/19, I requested that The Baltimore County Schools Office of Safe Schools retain the archived video footage of this incident until I can prepare a subpoena document.

The following officers and one Corporal arrived to the scene (prior to my arrival): Pace #4935, Rein #5338, Dunhadaway #5657, Fitzpatrick #6025, Smith #6051, and Corporal Kaschner #4935. Each of these departmental members will file a supplement with their observations of this incident.
