If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions in writing with reference to specific exemptions of the act.

The following record (s) are being requested

- All recordings of Baltimore County 911 tapes involving the

incident at the Tiki Lee's Dock Bar which occurred in or around the 4300 block of Sure Road in Dundalk/Sparrows Point, Maryland.

- The recordings should indicate both the Dundalk Precinct along with those officers responding from the Essex Precinct.
- Any and all tapes that would describe any possible situation leading up to the actual disturbance. That could include request for police traffic control just prior to the violence that occurred at the TLDB property.
- In addition please notify us that anyone else seeking this information according to the date and time of the particular request
